## Upcoming works: **OLD BAR ROAD, OLD BAR**



**Road reconstruction works along a 390m section of Old Bar Road, between Sheppard and David Streets, will commence on Tuesday 3 March.**

During the first 2 weeks, weather permitting, water crews will relocate water services in this busy stretch of Old Bar Road, starting at the David Street end and working their way up to Sheppard Street. Road closures will be required, with clearly marked detours in place, along with reduced speed limits around the area of works.

Crews will liaise with business and residents who are directly impacted during this initial phase, ensuring pedestrian access to properties is maintained. Parking restrictions will apply throughout the water services relocation phase.

Reconstruction of the road will follow this initial phase, kicking off towards the end of March. Along with reconstructing the road pavement, the project includes drainage improvements, reconstructing the speed hump (near David Street), replacing the pedestrian crossing (near Waterman/Cross Streets), applying an asphalt overlay, and renewed line-marking.

It is expected works will continue through to the end of May, weather-permitting, resulting in a smoother and safer travel route with improved drainage.

The full schedule of works and traffic control plans for the road reconstruction phase will be made available closer to the start date.
